

Cashless on-site parking

EDDINGTON
CAMBRIDGE

Use the JustPark App or a ticket from the parking machines to start your free 60 minute parking session.

To extend your parking beyond the first hour, use the App or parking machines to pay for additional time up to the maximum allowed for noted on the signage beside the parking bay.

Cashless payment options

To register for the free 60 minutes and to pay for parking, drivers can either use the cashless payment machines or via the JustPark app. See signage for location codes and parking restrictions.

Parking restriction

Most parking bays are allowed for a maximum period of 2 hours and no return within 1 hour, or as indicated on signage.

Parking charges notices

Parking charges notices will be issued to drivers and motorcyclists, including Blue Badge holders, for parking violations, including but not limited to:

- Parking on double yellow lines
- Parking in a disabled bay without a valid Blue Badge
- Parking in a permit holder area without a valid permit
- Parking without a valid ticket, even for the first hour

Blue Badge Holders

Blue Badge holders can park for free without using the machines or Just Park app, in designated bays only and when displaying a parking clock. Maximum stay limits apply. Tariffs and restrictions apply for all non-disabled bays.

Vistor Permits

Vistor Permits are available for all Eddington residents – both homeowners and university residents – to buy for their guests at a cost of £2.80 per day up to a maximum of 100 days per household per year. Details on how to purchase visitor permits are available on the Portal website. Visitor permits allow guests to park in any on-street pay and display space for up to 24 hours and can be used consecutively.
