On-street visitor parking is available as follows:

Mon-Fri 8am-6pm

INCLUDING PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

Sat-Sun 10am-5pm

INCLUDING PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

THE FIRST 60 MINUTES IS FREE

then £1 for every 30 minutes thereafter up to the maximum stay. Drivers must still obtain a ticket or register their vehicle by phone for the first free 60 minutes.

A MAXIMUM STAY OF 2 HOURS APPLIES IN MOST SPACES

(4 hours for the spaces near Storey's Field Centre and sports pitches).

NO RETURN WITHIN ONE HOUR IN MOST SPACES

(no return within 2 hours where maximum stay is 4 hours).

PAYMENT TERMINALS are placed in three locations across Eddington for visitors to pay for their parking - marked on map with blue hexagons. Drivers are also able to pay by phone with Redde (phone call, text or mobile app).

PARKING CHARGE NOTICES will be issued to drivers, including Blue Badge holders, for parking violations, including but not limited to:

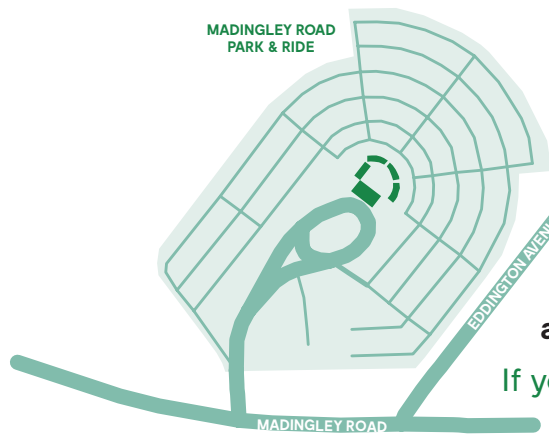
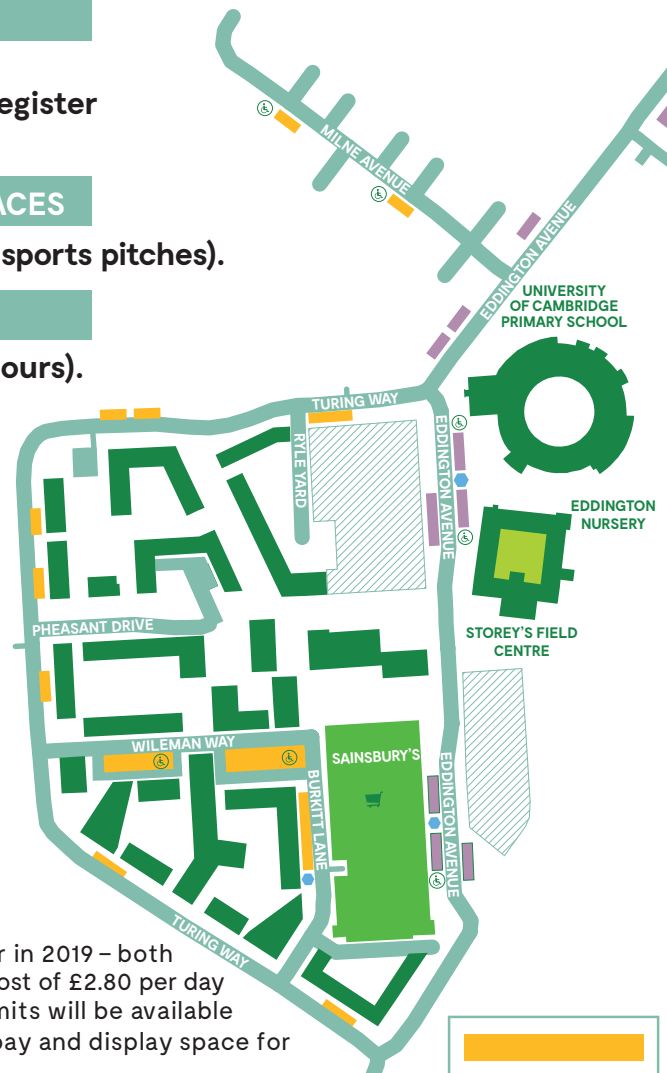
- Parking on double yellow lines
- Parking in a disabled bay without a valid Blue Badge
- Parking in a permit holder area without a valid permit
- Parking without a valid ticket, even for the first hour

BLUE BADGE HOLDERS can park for free without using the machines or Redde app, in marked disabled bays only and when displaying a parking clock. Maximum stay limits apply. Tariffs and restrictions apply for all non-disabled bays.

VISITOR PERMITS will be available for all Eddington residents later in 2019 - both homeowners and University residents - to buy for their guests at a cost of £2.80 per day up to a maximum of 100 days per household per year. Visitor permits will be available online. Visitor permits will allow guests to park in any on-street pay and display space for up to 24 hours and can be used consecutively.
