Housing Sub-Committee – expert committee members sought

Opportunity to Participate in Overseeing the University of Cambridge’s Housing Services. The University of Cambridge is seeking external committee members for its Housing Sub-Committee.

The Estates Division of the University of Cambridge is seeking applicants to serve on an important Housing committee. We are seeking volunteers to become members of the University Housing Sub-Committee, a newly established sub-committee that we expect to be formed in early 2025. The purpose of this sub-committee is to hold the University’s housing services to account in the delivery of housing, to ensure legislative and regulatory compliance, and to serve as a forum for stakeholder representation in relation to University housing and housing services.

The sub-committee will be chaired by a member of the University Estates Committee, it will include representation from various other University committees, and have two external members with expertise in housing-related compliance and regulation. Additionally, and in order to inform and understand the ‘lived experience’, the sub-committee is seeking a number of members who are currently resident in University housing.

Accordingly, Estates Division is now seeking external, subject-specialist applicants to serve on this sub-committee. This is an unpaid role, and applicants should be able to participate fully in the work of the sub-committee, to convene up to a maximum of four times per year, with each meeting lasting approximately three hours.
