Health Impact Assessment Clarification

March 2012

The Health Impact Assessment (September 2012) submitted for the Proposed Development includes a recommendation in section 10 (page 63) which suggest that further HIA work maybe required as the scheme progresses, and the specification for any further work will need to be agreed at the appropriate time. This statement provides clarification on the extent and scope of further HIA work and its relationship to the HIA submitted as part of the planning application for the Proposed Development.

Planning conditions and planning obligations will govern implementation of the Proposed Development in a manner which ensures that the measures and facilities outlined in the HIA are put in place. It is not envisaged, therefore, that further HIA work is required in relation to health impact assessment for the Proposed Development, either as part of the outline application or through reserved matters applications, if compliant with the outline permission. If considered necessary by the local planning authorities statements can, however, be submitted at agreed milestones confirming the measures and facilities that have been put in place during the relevant development period in compliance with the principles established within the HIA.
